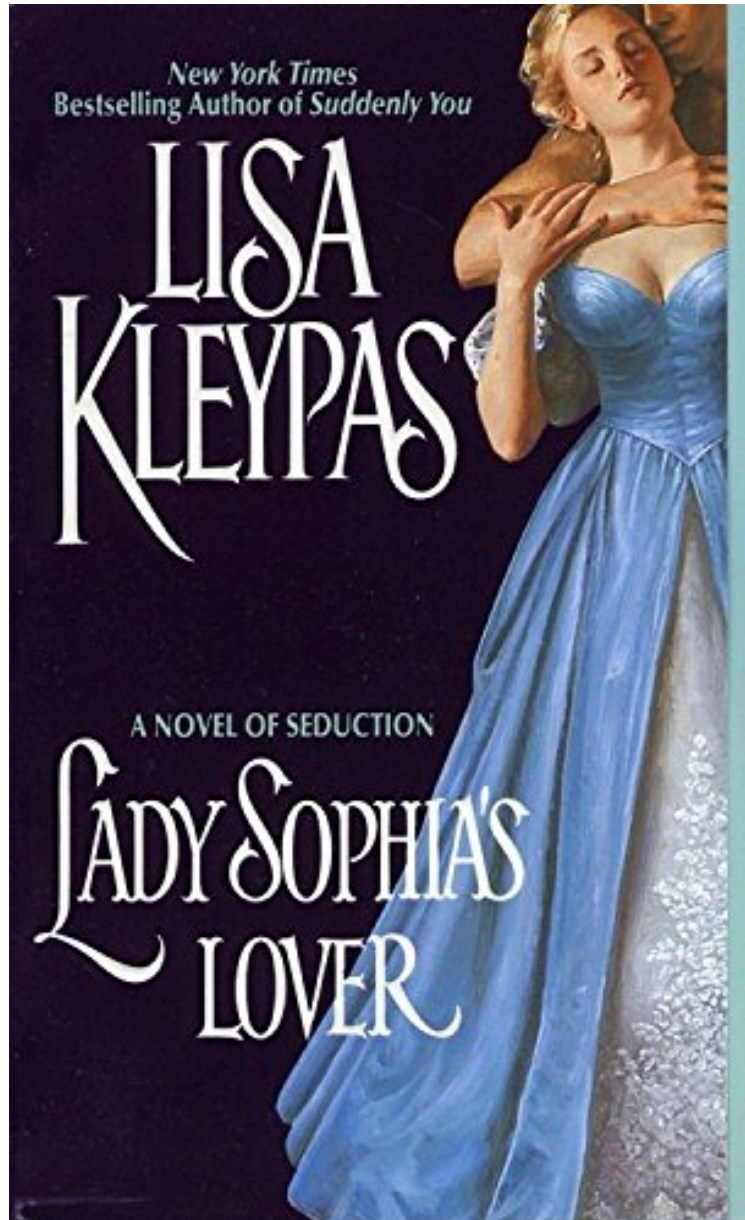

read was "Dreaming of you" and that one was so outstanding that by now I have read pretty much all of her work. "Lady Sophia's lover" is one of her best and it's right up there with "Dreaming of you". Sophia wants revenge against Ross Cannon, the magistrate of Bow Street. She believes him responsible for her brother's death and so she takes on the job as Ross's assistant. From the very first time Ross sees Sophia he is immensely attracted to her. Now, living under the same roof that attraction grows stronger every day, not just for Ross but for Sophia as well. Soon Sophia realizes that she can't go through with her plan of ruining Ross Cannon's reputation, because she can see that he is a noble and honest person. This book is definitely about Ross Cannon. Lisa Kleypas creates the most magnificent and awesome heroes, and Ross is no exception. He comes with a difficult past, having lost his first wife in childbirth, but once he acknowledges his growing feelings for Sophia, he doesn't withdraw but rather pursues Sophia and makes everything in his power to be with her. He is a hero to die for, strong, handsome, stubborn and incredibly sexy. I also liked Sophia very much, she takes a long time to trust Ross and come forward with her secret, but the author makes it plausible, showing how difficult it was for Sophia to grow up without her brother and being independent for the longest time. This book is also very sensual, there is a strong sexual tension between Sophia and Ross throughout the book and when they give in to their desire..... Von Schenni I had a lot of fun reading Sophia and Cannon's story. Lady Sophia wants to take revenge on the magistrate who was responsible for the death of her younger brother many years ago, by sentencing him to a stint in a prison hulk. So she worms her way into Sir Ross Cannon's household and his Bow Street office, where she plans to make him fall in love with her and then break his heart. She wants to make him suffer like she did for all those years, living without her brother. But the man she encounters isn't at all what she expected. So what is a woman supposed to do when she finds herself falling in love with the man she swore to bring down at any cost? Sophia was a courageous woman. Infiltrating a household of a magistrate and planning her revenge for her brother's death surely takes quite some courage. It might not have been a good idea and I definitely didn't agree with her master plan, but that doesn't change the fact that I respected her for her determination and loyalty. But what I liked even more about her was the fact that as soon as she recognized what a good man Cannon truly was she immediately let go of her grudge. I also have to congratulate the author for not making her former plans of revenge this huge, overblown issue. Instead she used the conflict to bond Sophia and Ross even closer together. Cannon was an extremely frustrating and endearing hero at the same time. His inability to cut himself some slack touched and made me angry in even measures. But exactly those high standards made him such a great hero. He had a truly good heart and he didn't expect things of others that he wasn't prepared to do himself. Despite their bad history Sophia and Ross shared a wonderful relationship. There were high amounts of trust, true affection and mutual understanding. While Sophia brought some much needed lightness and warmth into Cannon's life, Ross made Sophia feel safe and loved. I really enjoyed reading about those two. The only thing I could possibly complain about was Sophia's habit of keeping secrets from Ross, but since the revelations of those secrets were always handled without too much drama it wasn't that big a deal. Another great part of this book was the character of Nick Gentry. He was such an interesting secondary character and I just wished he would have gotten more page time. Although I have to confess that I might be a bit predisposed since I already read his book "Worth Any Price", book #3 in the Bow Street Runner series, which has been my favorite Kleypas novel outside of the Wallflower series. "Lady Sophia's Lover" was a delightful book with endearing characters, a fascinating plotline and a wonderful love story. Not as good as Nick's book or the Wallflower series, but still one of Lisa Kleypas' best historical romances.
