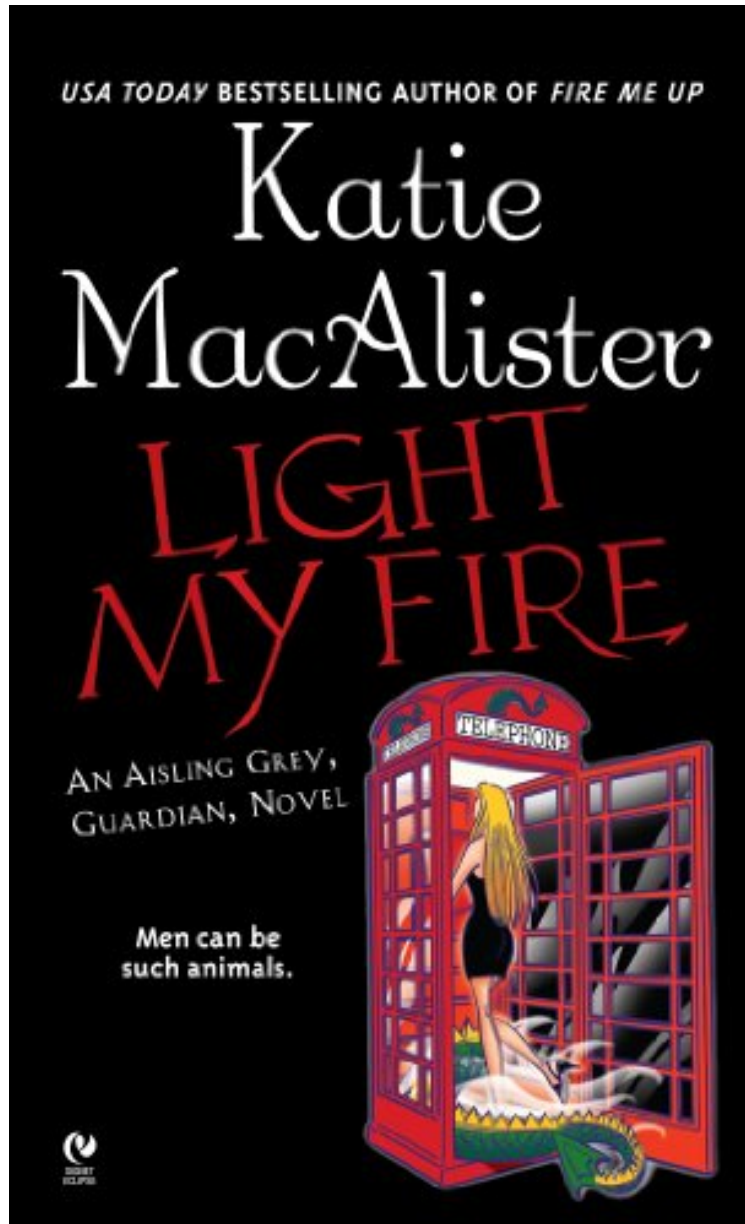

Aisling, demon lord, Guardian, and wyvern's mate, has just moved to London to finally receive some much-needed training on the duties and powers of a Guardian. From almost the moment she arrives at her mentor Nora's house, events just keep getting stranger.Jim, her trusty demon sidekick, manages to eat the imp king, ensuring Aisling a spot on the imp kingdom's most wanted list. Drake, the sexy wyvern Aisling can't resist, has just shown up in London and, in addition to making her pulse race, he tells her that the red dragons have just declared war on them. Dmitri, Drake's cousin, is challenging him for leadership of the sept and refuses to acknowledge Aisling as Drake's mate. Then again, Aisling isn't sure she wants to be Drake's mate since he's sure to break her heart for a third time.Almost from the opening pages, Light My Fire moves at breakneck speed. Aisling exists in a swirling mass of utter chaos, with crazy things happening to her at almost every turn. In the Aisling Grey, Guardian series, MacAlister has given herself ample room to stretch her humour muscles - and she has proven she has a deft comedic touch.MacAlister carefully balances this series between extremes: the comedy against the blazing passion of Aisling and Drake's relationship; the exasperation most feel around Aisling against her own determination to gain experience as a Guardian; and the large cast of secondary characters and supplementary plot lines against the story of Aisling's development into her place in the Otherworld. A fast-paced, funny thrill-ride that kept me turning the pages as fast as I could.I was happy to see that Aisling and Drake are finally starting to grow up. Especially Aisling comes across as more mature in this book and I liked that a lot. Her antics and one-liners are still hilarious, the scenarios she maneuvers herself into are still bizarre and laugh-out-loud funny. But overall she acts much more logical and grown-up than in previous books which works in her favor both for the readers enjoyment and to the utter astonishment of her adversaries who have to come to grips with this new Aisling.Other than that things are still the same. Nachdem der zweite Band der Serie ("Fire Me Up") die Beziehung zwischen Aisling und Drake mehr oder weniger gegen die Wand gefahren hatte, war ich sehr gespannt, wie die Autorin die Serie weiterentwickeln wrde. Nichts, was mir in den fnf Monaten, die ich auf den dritten Band warten musste, durch den Kopf ging, kam dabei dem, was in "Light My Fire" passiert, auch nur im Entferntesten nahe.Aisling und Drake bekommen ihre Probleme erstaunlich schnell in den Griff, was aber in diesem Band auch das einzige ist, was fr die beiden gut luft. Denn nicht nur gibt es innerhalb der grnen Drachen rger, die roten erklren ihnen den Krieg und auch Fiat, das Oberhaupt der blauen Drachen, fhrt wie immer nichts Gutes im Schilde. But her presence is still required at a meeting of the green dragons. Since several attempts have been made on her life, Drake is sure to get protective of her. Which might not be a bad thing when war breaks out and all hell breaks loose-literally.From BooklistMacAlister's third paranormal Aisling Grey novel takes her heroine and her pet demon, Jim (who looks like a Newfoundland dog), to London, where she is apprenticing to Nora to learn the Guardian trade. She is soon on the hot seat when Jim eats the Imp king, but that may be the least of her problems since the Green and Red dragon clans are now at war, and someone wants her dead. Theimps do torch Nora's house so Aisling, Nora, and Jim move into the London mansion of Drake Vireo, green-eyed wyvern, and sparks fly. Then, kidnapped while wearing only a towel, Aisling is pitched from the frying pan into the fire when she is then stolen from her kidnappers and required to draw on her dark powers to vanquish a Demon Lord. MacAlister's crazy paranormal high jinks, delightful characters, and simmering romance between Aisling and Drake
