Early on, he learned that werewolves are big, muscled, brave, scary and fierce - and most of all: dominant. Tim is small, even tiny for a were. And he yearns to be held down, to be the bottom. He is drawn to big alpha types - fearing

them at the same time and being ashamed for his wishes. He never learned to be a were, isn't able to interpret scents like other weres do all the time. He needs people to spell things out for him to understand them. Being locked away from other weres for being a freak and a shame for his family, he never learned to live in a were society. Nathaniel is all Tim admires: tall, alpha and the perfect shifter. He doesn't need words to communicate, he relies on scents and his shifter senses and instincts. Meeting Tim, a were who doesn't even know what instincts mean, is the beginning of lots of misunderstandings. But he will do the noble thing and allow Tim to figure all out on his own - which means Nathanael has to wait an eternity for Tim to notice what the whole city already knows: Tim and Nathanael belong together. The story itself is nice, the characters lovely, their actions (mostly) understandable. For such a long, long story it is astounding that nearly nothing happens. The various insecurities of Tim are epically described, repeated, explained and - for good measure - analyzed again. After the first third of the book with no happenings at all, I found myself skipping passages and pages. It wasn't really boring, but a bit annoying. It seems like the book is written in slowmotion and the reader is forced to suffer along without getting anywhere. Every tiny scene - important or not - is overly stretched out and artificially prolonged (often times with Tim's problems to understand weres). Sex scenes - worth a couple of pages at best - are blown until they are thirty or forty pages long. Nice, even funny dialogues are stretched until you have to look for the last question, because the answer is a couple of pages later - hidden between pages of Tim's tries to interpret Nathanael's scents or his admiration for Nathanael's gorgeous body or his noble character or how Tim isn't worth such a perfect werewolf - or even all of these things combined. Therefore, the reading was not always enjoyable and I skipped more and more pages just to get over with this book. Cut short to half its lengths it might be fantastic. Like this it is nice with interruptions of annoying, trying, overwhelming (and not in a good way) and a few boring passages. Lots and lots and LOTS of passages that are quite irrelevant for the understanding, because it has all been said numerous times before. She's dragging out Tim's cluelessness to almost insufferable levels, too. Another thing is that this book, unlike her other beings stories, is more conventional. It really is all "alpha" and "mate" and "smells" and the whole package, where the other books took a more humorous look at the were image and the prejudices.
