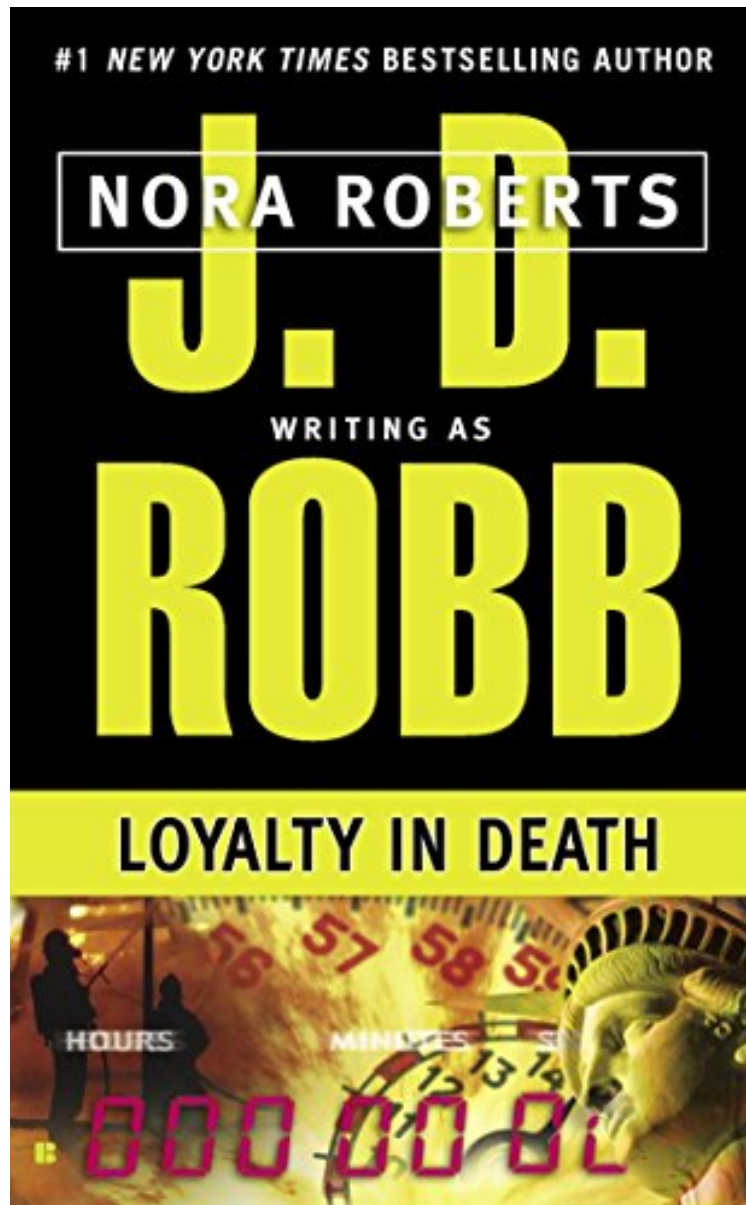

Für Spannungen sorgt, dass Eves Ehemann Roarke es sich als Besitzer der zerbombten Gebäude wieder einmal nicht nehmen lässt, sich gegen ihren ausdrücklichen Willen in die Ermittlungen einzumischen. Noch schwieriger wird die Situation für Eve, als auch noch Zeke, der Bruder ihrer Assistentin Peabody, der gerade zu Besuch in New York ist, in einen Mord verwickelt wird. Für empfindsame Gemüter ist diese recht harte Sci-Fi-Krimi-Serie eher nicht geeignet. Aber alle anderen sollten keine Sekunde zögern, sich auch diesen Band zu besorgen, denn J. D. Robb zieht mal wieder alle Register. Die Geschichte ist gut durchdacht und so spannend, dass man, einmal dabei, das Buch kaum mehr aus der Hand legen kann. Das Wiedersehen mit den liebgewonnenen Charakteren macht Spaß, und die Szenen zwischen Eve und ihrem Ehemann Roarke sind so brandheiß, dass man fast befürchtet, das Papier, auf dem sie gedruckt sind, müsste jede Sekunde in Flammen aufgehen. The "In Death" series is very nearly perfect - I've seen reviews from readers who say the plots are not realistic - I have enough reality in my life - that's why I read romantic mysteries. The dialogue between Eve and Roarke is marvelous, as it is between McNab and Peabody, and I adore the fact that Summerset cuddles Galahad when neither thinks anyone is watching. The love scenes between Eve and Roarke are exquisite - graphic enough to be exciting but never slipping over the line to distasteful. Roarke, of course, is everything most of us want in a man, and he adores his Darling Eve who is tough, smart and totally at sea as to why this man should love her so desperately.
