Feels like a scam Von Annanym This book felt like a scam to me. Why? The progress the story makes is minimal. There is no character development. There is next to no progress at all to the relationships between any of the characters. The newly introduced characters are boring and stereotypical. I can clearly see that this book is what happens when you need to make money out of a series in which you already used up your most interesting ideas. This book was boring to no ends and apart from killing of many interesting characters I didn't feel like it did anything at all. As much as I liked the setting and idea of The Others series, I will not be buying anymore of Bishops works after this. Sadly she seems to run out of ideas, as most characters - even in their description! (the colouring of Simon W. oddly reminds me of the SaDiablo men) -, their adventures and the trials they have to face (Meg, Jaenelle, Daemon - is it some sort of basic requirement for a heroine/hero of Bishops novels to be raped and later on having a narrational focus on their coping with it? Also the whole problem-of-filtering-the-bad-guys-out-of-a-pool-of-good-guys.... three seperate novels, all with this as it's story-focus) seem really repetitive. I strongly recommend to start with 'Written in Red'. Review It's no secret that this is one of my favorite [urban] fantasy series and so my review is heavily biased by the fan-girl-soul residing inside of me. But fan-girl or no, this series is amazing: a very unique and strong world-building and characters that feel not only real, but make you believe that there could be Others outside, that nature just could be that sentient. Each person has his or her own voice and you'd never mistake one of the wolfgard ['Aroo?'] with one of the crowgard or, least of all, a human. And as a recurrent theme there are the various misconceptions between Others, humans and the cassandra sangue. I love their interactions and their common puzzlement about the strange behavior of the respective other group. Although this time, the followers of the 'Humans first and last'-party manage to not only cut off any dialogue between [most] humans and terra indigene, but to reach the tipping-point where Namid's 'teeth and claws' start getting into the game. And boy do you not want them in the game... the first half of the book is a constant and nerve-wrecking buildup of suspense. The POVs change constantly and show the various settlements and players and how slowly, oh so slowly, the pieces are brought into place. And I bit my nails and couldn't stop reading, I was so incredibly captivated! Then there is the huge and thorough showdown that feels a lot like a tsunami, a wave starting small and ending in devastation. And who [if anyone] will survive, is unclear for a long time. With each book, this series got a wider scope: it started with Meg and Simon Wolfgard in 'Written in Red' and is now the story of a whole continent. Actually, Meg has not a lot of page-time and although I missed her a bit, the other POVs and the progress in the overall story arc made up for it. Especially since I was given some very cute and fitting development in Meg and Simon's relationship. I was more than happy to read that there will be another installment and even if a huge story-arc is finished, there surely is room for more.
