ReviewWith the last book, a new antagonist was introduced, the cunning, machiavellian head of the nefarious Circle. And as Merit and her friends and colleagues feared, he was not at all finished, but had just started. But none has any idea, what his endgame would be and they stay puzzled for a long time. Especially since there are a lot of things happening that seem to be related to the Circle, but they just don't add up, there isn't a plan showing. It all starts with a shifter killed by a vampire and lots of alchemist signs in particular places. As is the usual proceeding in the Chicagoland Vampires-books, Merit and Ethan find themselves in the midst of all the havoc. They stumble upon the dead shifter and see it as their job to investigate and try to not let the ties between Gabriel's shifter-pack and the Cadogan vampires dissolve. Which proves to be pretty hard. Then there is the alchemy that takes all of Chicago's friendly sorcerers to slowly slowly find out what it is about [and what it is about is actually pretty scary]. It's all of the usual posse taking part in the story and as usual, I like watching their interactions. Although I was glad that Merit could stop the fan-girl gushing about her wonderful, beautiful, powerful Master vampire sometime. I mean, I love Darth Sullivan, I really do, but I like Merit a lot more, whenever she stands up to him. Which she does a lot, too, to be just. And I also have to admit that he does something very adorable. Some things actually. That he also makes wrong decisions kind of makes him more human, so I won't hold that against him. Especially since he realizes his mistake. There is a necromancer they get to know and she is someone, I would love to read more about, she was someone I liked instantaneously.
