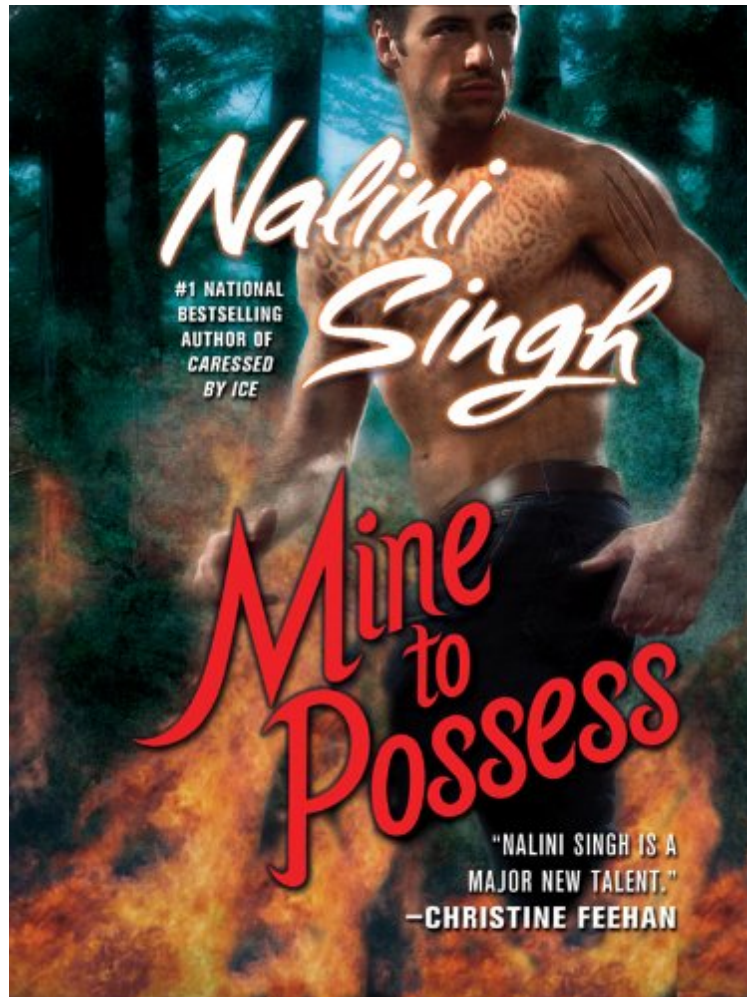

Seit Wochen vermeint er, den Geruch seiner Kindheitsfreundin Talin in San Francisco wahrzunehmen. Unmgligh, hatte man ihm doch vor Jahren mitgeteilt, sie sei bei einem Autounfall gestorben. Fr Clay brach damals eine Welt zusammen und nur das Dark River Rudel konnte ihm neuen Lebensmut geben. Jetzt steht Talin leibhaftig vor Clay und bittet ihn um Hilfe. Clay ist vor Wut und Zorn ber Talins damalige Tuschung auer sich, kann ihr jedoch nach wie vor nichts abschlagen.

Gemeinsam untersuchen sie das Verschwinden von Straenkindern, die unter Talins Obhut standen und von denen befürchtet wird, dass sie das Opfer eines Psychopathen wurden. Nachdem es in den bisherigen drei Bänden in Nalini Singhs Psi-Gestaltwandler-Serie jeweils um eine Beziehung zwischen Gestaltwandler und Psi ging, war ich skeptisch, ob es der Autorin gelingen würde, eine Beziehung zwischen Mensch und Gestaltwandler genauso fesselnd und emotional zu gestalten. Dies gelingt jedoch ausgezeichnet, denn Clay und Talins verschiedene Traumata sorgen für mehr als genügend Konfliktstoff. Die Psi-Welt spielt hier keine so große Rolle wie in den bisherigen Bänden, ist aber dennoch präsent genug, um begonnene Handlungsstränge zufriedenstellend weiterzuführen und bereits die Weichen für den nächsten Band zu stellen. Nalini Singhs Serie gehört wirklich mit zum besten, was es im "paranormal romance" Genre derzeit gibt und ist auch mit dem vierten Band noch so spannend und mitreißend wie zu Beginn. Neueinsteiger sollten allerdings mit "Slave To Sensation" beginnen (trotz des kitschigen Titels), da immer wieder auf Ereignisse in früheren Bänden eingegangen wird. 9 von 10 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. Gelungene Fortsetzung der Changeling-Psi Reihe Von Klonk-ADies ist bereits der 4. Band in der Reihe um die Changeling-Psi-Mensch Welt. Nalini Singh schafft es einmal mehr ein stimmiges Bild von dieser Gesellschaft zu zeichnen. Während in den ersten 3 Bänden Held und Heldin sich erst kennen lernten, gibt es hier bereits eine Vorgeschichte zwischen Clay und Talin, was eine gelungene Abwechslung darstellt, zumal endlich auch einmal die Menschen mit einbezogen werden. Bisher gab es ja den Konflikt zwischen Psi und Changelings und daraus gemixte Liebespaare, während auf die Bedeutung der Menschen (Worker Bees) für diese Gesellschaft bisher nicht eingegangen wurde. Die Handlung findet wieder im Umfeld der Leoparden statt und man trifft die meisten der vertrauten Figuren aus den ersten 3 Bänden wieder, leider ohne größere Auftritte der Wölfe. Es ist auf jeden Fall wieder sehr spannend, wie die Autorin ihre Welt weiter vor uns aufrollt und der Leser immer mehr deren Geheimnisse entdeckt. Fourth in Psy/Changeling series Von Helen Hancox This is the fourth in Nalini Singh's series of books about the world of the Psy, Changelings and Humans. The first two books "Slave to Sensation" and "Visions of Heat" featured Psy women who escaped from the world of Mr Spock-like emotionless after finding their mates amongst the Changelings big cats. The third book, "Caressed by Ice", took Werewolf Brenna as the heroine and Psy assassin Judd as the hero. This fourth book is the first that introduces a human as one of the main subjects Talin McKay. Tally is a social worker whose troubled childhood still haunts her as did her only real friend in her youth, Clay. Clay is a Leopard Changeling and when he killed Tally's abusive foster father and went to prison for the crime Tally disappeared from his life, requesting that he be told she had died in a car accident. However when some of the children Tally oversees go missing and then are found dead she realises that she needs assistance to get to the bottom of the disappearances and her former friend Clay, now an important person in the DarkRiver Pack, can help. The Clay she knew as a young boy has changed into a wild and dangerous man of whom she is initially afraid. When Clay brings Tally back to his pack and she starts to interact with the others they work together to find out what's happened to the young people and it's a race against time to rescue young Jon before he is killed. But can Clay and Tally get past the issues of mistrust and abandonment of the previous twenty years in order to find their friendship again - and perhaps more? The characters in the previous books all appear in this one, along with a couple of new characters who will probably feature in future books. Once again Nalini Singh has written a tightly-plotted and enjoyable book with her alternative world with the Psy/Changeling/Human triumvirate taking on a new twist. As with the previous three books much of the romance between hero and heroine is based on physical touch, 'skin privileges', and although Tally isn't Psy she is a damaged young woman because of her past. I wonder what the author would do if one of her characters didn't mind touch as that's such a part of her writing style! She wrote the character of Clay very well as a part-animal, part human and a frightening but also loyal and reliable man. Tally wasn't always as easy to get a handle on and the underlying thread of her illness was dealt with in a rather easy way. Still, like the other books in the series, this was a worthwhile read and I look forward to the next book.
