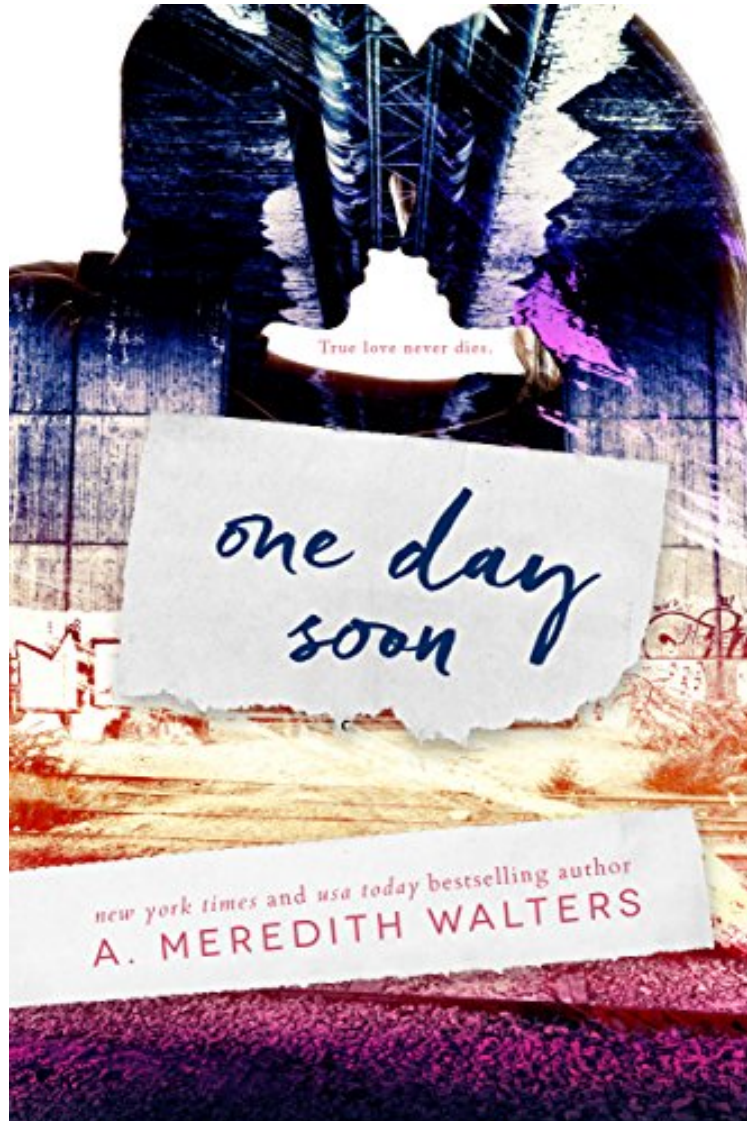

Als die 16-jährige Imi damals von zu Hause weglief, war sie sich nicht wirklich klar darüber gewesen, welche Art von Leben sie auf der Straße erwarten würde. Es war pure Glück gewesen, da sie gleich am ersten Tag Yoss über den Weg lief. Yoss, der sie vor einem aufdringlichen Typen rettete und sich von da an um sie kümmerte. Der sein Essen mit ihr teilte und ihr einen trockenen Schlafplatz suchte. Der alles tat, um Imi zu beschützen. Ihr Retter. Ihr Freund. Ihre Liebe. Yoss, den sie nie wieder gesehen hat, seitdem er sie unter jener Brücke zurückgelassen hatte. 15 Jahre später begegnen wir Imi wieder. Sie arbeitet heute als Sozialarbeiterin in einem Krankenhaus. Sie hat ein Haus, einen Exmann, einzelne Freunde. Sie liebt ihren Job und lebt für ihn - doch man merkt schnell, da sie innerlich zerbrochen ist. Heute wird ihr ein neuer Fall zugeteilt, der über Nacht in die Klinik eingeliefert worden war: Ein Obdachloser der brutal verprügelt und schwer verletzt worden ist... Es ist Yoss. Der Yoss, auf den Imi vor 15 Jahren vergeblich unter der Brücke gewartet hatte. Der Yoss, den sie bis heute nicht vergessen konnte... Diese gesamte Geschichte ist einfach nur herzerreißend. Die Kapitel wechseln ab zwischen der Gegenwart und der 15 Jahre zurückliegenden Vergangenheit. Wir erleben diese unglaublich seltsame Teenagerliebe zwischen Yoss und Imi und ihren harten Überlebenskampf auf der Straße. Der 18-jährige Yoss ist so ein toller Charakter in seinem Drang, für die Menschen, die ihm nahestehen, da zu sein. Auch, wenn er in seiner verzweiferten Situation nicht immer die richtigen Entscheidungen getroffen hat und trifft. So sehr man dieser Liebe auch eine Zukunft wünscht - die harte Realität stellt sich immer wieder in den Weg. Versprechen werden gebrochen. Hoffnungen zerstört. Und am Schluss steht ein Mädchen allein unter einer Brücke und ihr Herz zerbricht. Doch dann begegnen sich Yoss und Imi 15 Jahre später in diesem Krankenhaus wieder. Was haben weitere 15 Jahre auf der Straße bei Yoss angerichtet? Die Wiederbegegnung der beiden ist schwierig. Yoss ist verbittert und aufbrausend. Er stößt alles und jeden weg. Doch Imi ist in ihrer Geduld und ihrem Vertrauen ebenso hartnäckig. Denn immer klarer wird, da keiner von beiden jemals mit dem anderen abgeschlossen hat. Gibt es im Leben zweite Chancen? Oder muss Imi begreifen, da ein gemeinsames Leben für sie und Yoss nie vorgesehen war? Die Verwicklung, die die Autorin hier einführt, um die möglich erscheinende zweite Chance für die Protagonisten zu gefährden, werde ich hier nicht verraten. Ich kann aber versprechen, da dabei kein Auge trocken bleiben wird. Dieses Buch ist unglaublich emotional und mitreißend. Ich konnte es wirklich nicht aus der Hand legen, weil ich so gefesselt war und einfach wissen musste, wie es weiter geht. Und bis zum Schluss war mir nicht klar, wie es ausgehen würde. (Interessanterweise hatte die Autorin ursprünglich einen anderen Schluss geplant und hat sich erst während des Schreibens umentschieden. Es ist also wirklich alles möglich.) Nur zwei kleine Kritikpunkte habe ich. Erstens glaube ich nicht, da man nach 15 Jahren einfach da anknüpfen kann, wo man als Teenager aufgehört hat. Da fehlt mir eindeutig ein Neu-Kennenlernen und Neu-Verlieben. Und zweitens gibt es gegen Ende ein einzelnes Kapitel, das aus Yoss' Sicht geschrieben ist. Und in diesem Kapitel geschieht leider genau das, was sonst in dem ganzen Buch so erfreulicherweise vermieden worden war: Es gleitet in totalen Kitsch ab. He takes care of Imi from then on out, gives her shelter, provides food as best as he can and sacrifices everything he has for his love. Both of them know that this arrangement cant last forever and they hope for a future away from the streets but definitely with each other. Until one rash decision costs them their happy life together WOW; WOW; WOW!!! I cant put it any other way. This book was a definite winner for me. Its only February but I can already say that One day soon is one of the best books Ill be reading this year! Its THAT beautiful. Like always in A. Meredith Walters books, there are tender subjects handled, that are mostly hushed to death by society. Me personally, I can only bow in awe for this amazing and courageous author for putting names to sore subjects and doing that with the grace of a poet! In One day soon, we have alternating chapters of the present and the past (from 15 years ago, when they were 16 and 19 years old). The telling, however, is only in Imis POV. Because of every second chapter being about teenagers albeit very mature ones Id say it had a definite Young Adult-vibe to it. But let me tell you, Im normally not a fan of Young Adult but in this case, it was perfect for the whole build-up of the book! It wasnt filled to the brim with teenage stupidity, since the characters involved had to worry about completely other problems. There was descriptive sex, but only close to the ending and it wasnt overly explicit. However, this book deals with a lot of issues that are very delicate, and although they are unfortunately the harsh and ugly reality for a lot of people in this world, you cant really wrap your head around everything youre reading in One day soon, if you havnt lived through it personally. Suffice to say, that I was shocked to my core more than once. My heart literally hurt for the cruel curveballs live threw Imis and Yoss way. I cant really tell you how much I cried and sat there with a hand clamped over my mouth to prevent myself from screaming my empathic pain for those beautiful souls out loud.
