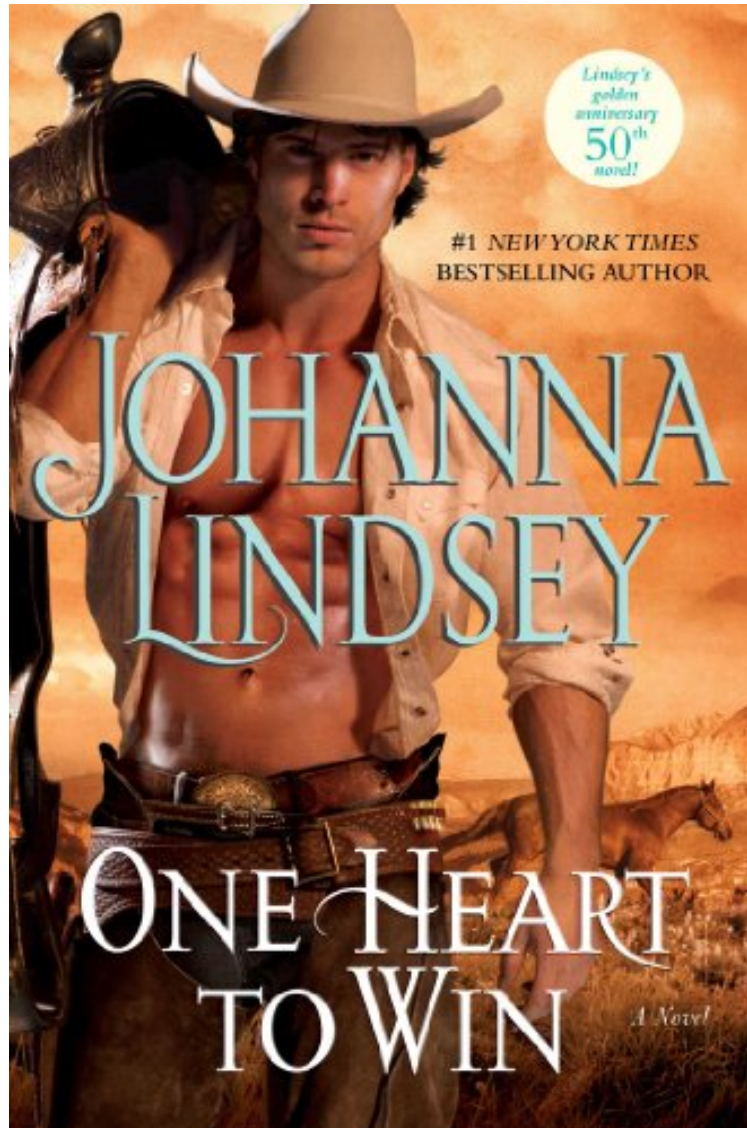

published 1994. 1 day to read the first book, 1 day to read the 2nd and 1 more to read the last one, this means I liked the series. 20 years passed since the first book and the meeting of Garrick and Brenna, some 5-6 years from the second about Kirsten and Royce. Selig Haardrad has decided to move close to his sister, to build his life in the Land of the Saxons. When he has nothing better to do he decides to accompany the king's man on a diplomatic mission to the invading Danes. His convoy is attacked, he is left for dead. When he is looking for help he is mistaken by Erika of Gronwood who orders his wiping out of hurt feelings as she feels offended by his seductive way. Even though she regrets immediately afterwards it is too late to prevent some whipping. When his sister comes to save him he wants revenge and takes Erika with him, to "never see her laugh again". As he can't hurt her physically he wants to humiliate her. Erika refuses to fight being ashamed of her behavior at first. But Selig is an amazingly handsome and charming and she is a beauty herself and how long can he be angry against her when he is so attracted by her? I really like both main characters and enjoyed the fact that the characters from the previous book have a real role in this one, the near encounter at the lake of the three couples was nice. Erika was not as strong as the women from the previous books and Selig not a hard headed. I have the feeling that I was missing some drama, some intensity even the sex scenes are not very hot, somehow it didn't kick off. The ending however was nice but still too fast as for me everything is happening at the beginning and at the end, but too fast. I also liked Erika's shadow and how his life seems to evolve at the end. Overall this is a very good book, but not as amazing as the other two so I would give it 4,5 stars because it is a nice conclusion of the trilogy and it kept me reading and reading and reading.... When his relatives come to get him, he insists that they take Erika prisoner so he can punish her. But even though he keeps her in chains and mocks her, he also feels attracted to her. They can have a future together, but will first need to resolve their mixed feelings for each other and old misunderstandings. Erika was in turn too weak for my taste. And I loved Hearts Aflame, but Kirsten from that book took up way too much space in this one and was nasty. I didn't understand how Selig's mother could even tolerate her son doing the things he did to Erika, being how strong she was in Fires of Winter.
