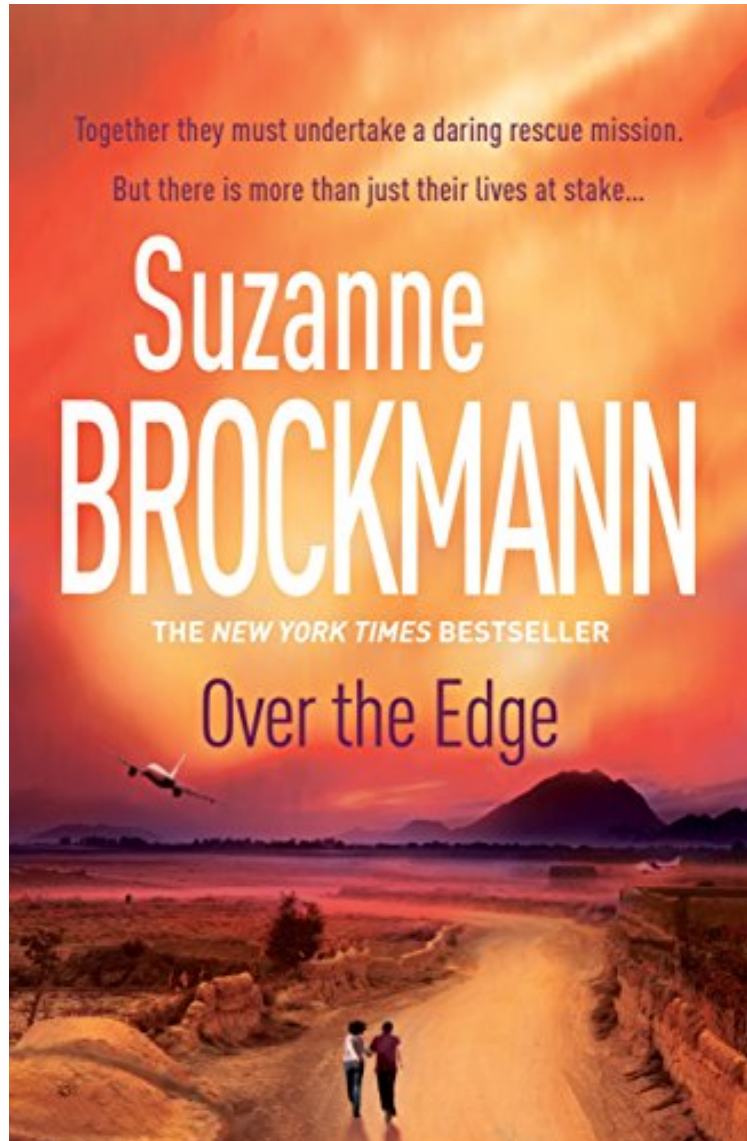

An action-packed novel by one of romance's hottest pensVon Vivien LubojanskyReading OVER THE EDGE was a bit like watching movies like AIR FORCE ONE with a big dash of romance and not only one, but five Harrison Fords \*and\* a few strong female characters thrown in! It was a thriller made in romance novel land, with enough tension and

suspense to have me biting my nails towards the end, but also lots of sparkling dialogue, great love scenes and likeable characters. As usual, Brockmann interweaves three story lines: the main love story is about Teri, helo pilot and Stan, Navy SEAL. They are involved with rescuing an aircraft abducted by terrorists. The secondary love stories are about the by now notorious Sam and Alyssa, well-known from previous books, and a Danish couple in WWII, one of them Jewish. The WWII romance was interesting, but not really great, mainly because it wasn't told from one of the protagonists' point of view. Teri and Stan's story was sweet: Teri is a shy and secretive woman who has to endure a lot of sexual taunts from her colleagues, Stan is a thoroughly decent, good-humoured guy who thinks he has to protect her at all costs. Teri doesn't like his fatherly behaviour and tells him so, which makes for some amusing scenes. Their interaction was very well described and the dialogue, as usual, was scintillating. Sam and Alyssa's story, however, has become the main thread that makes those books page-turners and gives me the emotional punch I love in romances. Admittedly, romances between people who have a hard time recognising and owning up to their feelings are not everyone's cup of tea, but I usually enjoy them, even if it hurts. And Sam and Alyssa do put you through the wringer emotionally! Fighting, throwing insults at each other, both trying to curb the irresistible attraction, having great sex, separating, breaking up. If, like me, you like this emotional turmoil, you are likely to be very moved by their story. If you enjoy intense, suspenseful, but also very romantic stories, written in a wonderful style with modern, life-like characters, OVER THE EDGE is just the ticket for you.

Von Ein Kunde I really love Suzanne Brockmann's books and am working my way through all of them, re-reading while waiting to get new ones!! She's got a great writing style and I'm on the edge of my sofa reading and laughing out loud as well sometimes!! I really like the fact that she writes about people who know each other so you get a glimpse of the next hero when reading her books!! Stan and Teri are a wonderful couple!!! Teri is sweet but strong and working through her problems but not letting them keep her from her job. Stan is so cute who wouldn't totally fall in love with her!! Unlike other romance novel heroes he isn't an arrogant man who's convinced the heroine wants him and is smug about it. He's got a few insecurities for example about his looks and thinks at first a beautiful woman like Teri couldn't possibly want an ugly guy like him, which is soo sweet and really made me like him. Also the fact that he tries to do what's best for Teri trying to set her up with someone else is unselfish and great! Basically he's a genuinely NICE guy which is lovely in a book hero where tough often seems to be more important than nice, not that he's not really tough too, he definitely is!!!!
