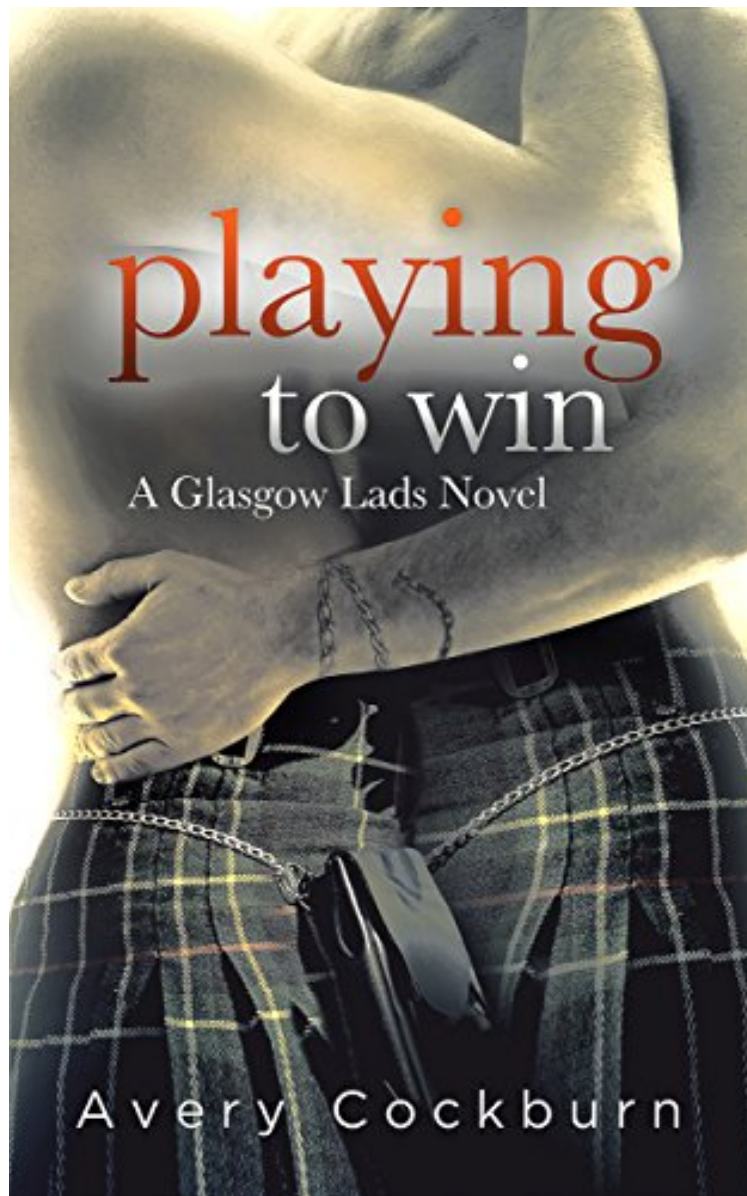

Sometimes I forgot they're only 19/20 years old. I often wondered where their relationship would lead, not at all predictable. Super! Maybe some people mind the politics - and yes there was maybe a teeny weeny bit too much of it for the general reader - but did I care? I loved it, actually. Avery Cockburn creates two wonderfully complex, totally different characters with a completely different set of problems. To be honest, I could not see for most of the book how they could work out together. At all. In the end Andrew takes a huge leap of faith for love's sake. He gives so much, he sacrifices so much to be who he is and to be with who he loves. I'm dying to know what happens next - if his father really disowned him, how is he going to survive? Colin is right to fear he might feel bitter if his family never speaks to him again. So how is that going to work out? And most of all, please please let Andrew keep Gretchen and the boathouse. It sounds magical - unlike swimming in a Scottish Loch whatever the season may be (it is ALWAYS freezing! :) Colin (and that dimple in the corner of his mouth) reminds me of a certain British actor who would have been brilliant playing this part. No idea if Ms Cockburn had the same image in her head when she wrote that character. He so desperately needs someone to love him in a steady, unflappable way. I take my hat off to his strong will to succeed, to his enthusiasm and his idealism. His maturity belies his tender age, but emotionally he is in a very fragile place. I love how he finds his peaceful, steady heaven with Andrew. But Good God these guys will have a lot of issues to deal with in the future. I must give special kudos to the beautifully scripted love scenes between these two. Intense, hot and breathtaking right down to teary-eyed, tender and simply beautiful.
