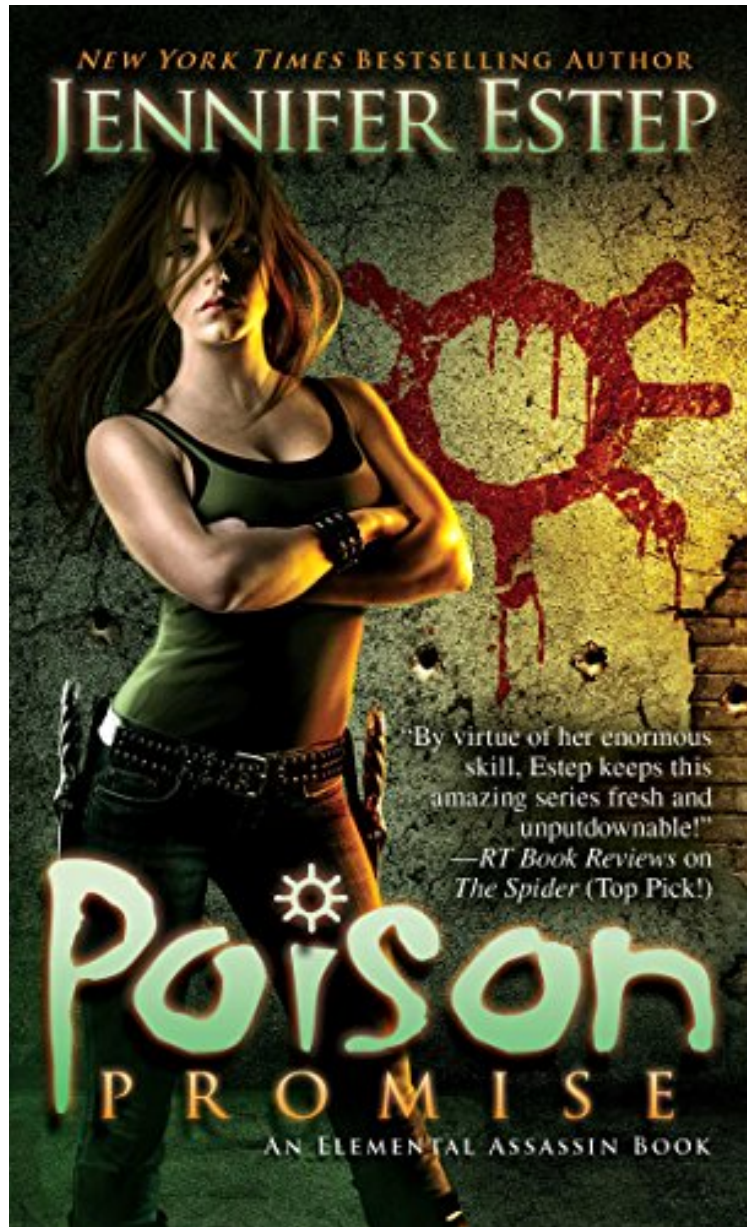

Estep makes it easy to get back into the series, the characters and their relationships developed over a lot of prior installments and you'd miss out on a lot, if you skipped that. So: if new to the series, I recommend to stop reading here and start with Spider's Bite.ReviewAfter Gin had offed Mab Monroe a few installments back, there was a bit of a lull in the worthy adversary department for the assassin and I was wondering what that meant for the series in the long run. Don't get me wrong, Gin still had had epic battles and the vampire she killed in the south, the creep who abducted Sophia or Owen's ex, they made life hard for Gin and her friends and family but there was never a doubt that Gin would end them and outwit them on the way to their respective demise.But I shouldn't have doubted Jennifer Estep, because with this book she provided us with two things: an opponent who poses an imminent and intense threat to Gin and Bria and the promise of an even worse enemy for future books, who will deliver on the worthy part and who will not be overcome that easy, if at all [OK, I have faith in Gin, but it will be hard!]. But it all starts with a weary and tired Gin: she is fed up with the permanent attempts on her life, since Ashland's mob bosses think killing her would be a step towards the still empty throne to rule over the town's criminal gangs. So when she gets drawn into her sister Bria's case against the ruthless King of Southtown, a vampire with the ability to kill people by sucking their emotions as well as their life force out of them, she is rather... unwilling.Problem is that it's become personal for Bria, so she won't let go and although Gin for once just wants to be left alone, she steps up when her sister and friends are threatened. Because this is how Gin is. And again, Bria is not my favorite person at all. I perpetually want to push her from her high horse of righteousness: detesting Gin for being an assassin, but if it suits her, she frets that Gin doesn't kill the gangster boss when presented with the possibility. Oh the hypocrisy!But ironically, the confrontation with the vampire is exactly what Gin needs to get back into her life as the Spider. She obviously needed the wake-up call and realize that the mobsters would never leave her alone, if she didn't show them, what they'd have to face if they didn't stop. And show them she did. Oh my, Gin is even more amazing than when going against Mab: the vampire underestimates her and although she needs luck and allies to get out of a dire situation, she is ultimately prevailing and big time. It was wonderful reading about her being back in the best way possible [I still wonder what it says about me that I adore her in all her assassin's glory and snarkiness]!After an epic showdown and a satisfying wrap-up of this story, there is still another thing to be revealed: the new big bad opponent shows himself and Gin's outlook on her and her friend's future becomes considerably darker in the blink of an eye... which makes for a great premise in future installments.
