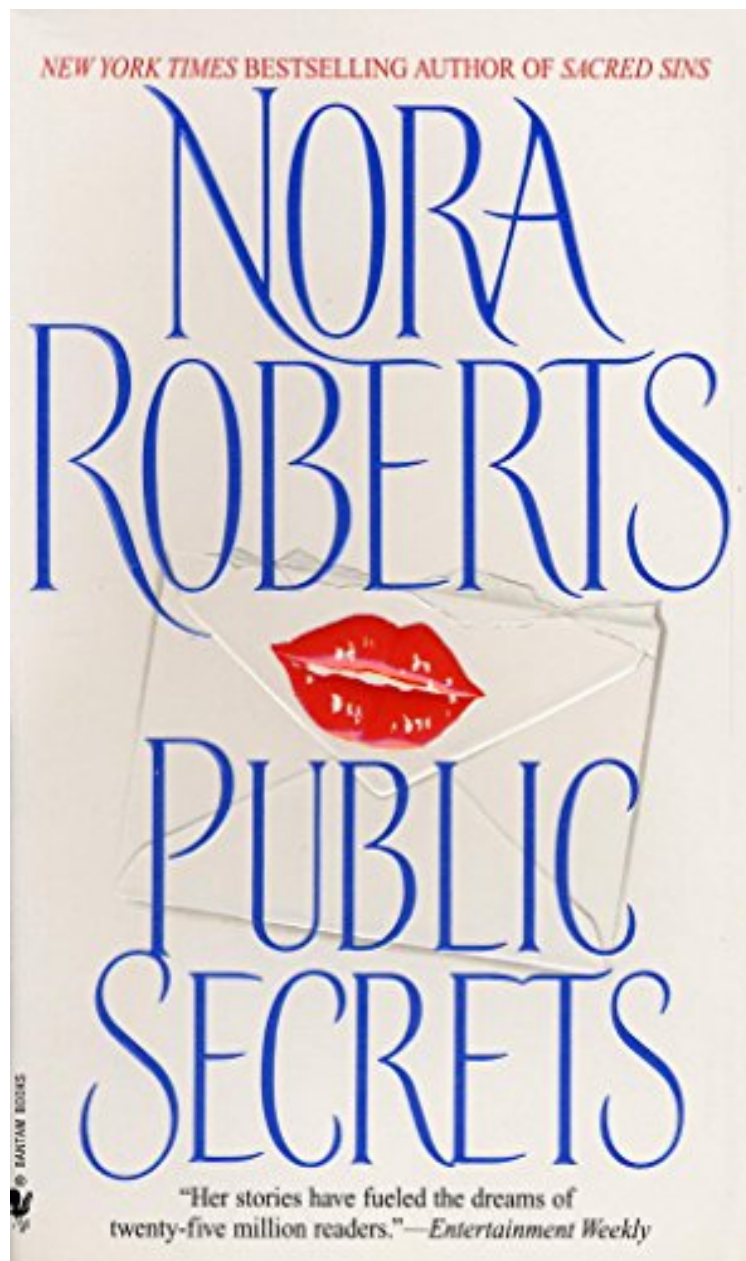

While I liked her father Brian, he also had a major drinking problem and his friends had their own hangups. Michael, son of the cop investigating the murder of Darren, half-brother to Emma, is perfect for her but it took so long for them to figure it out. Overall a good story.
