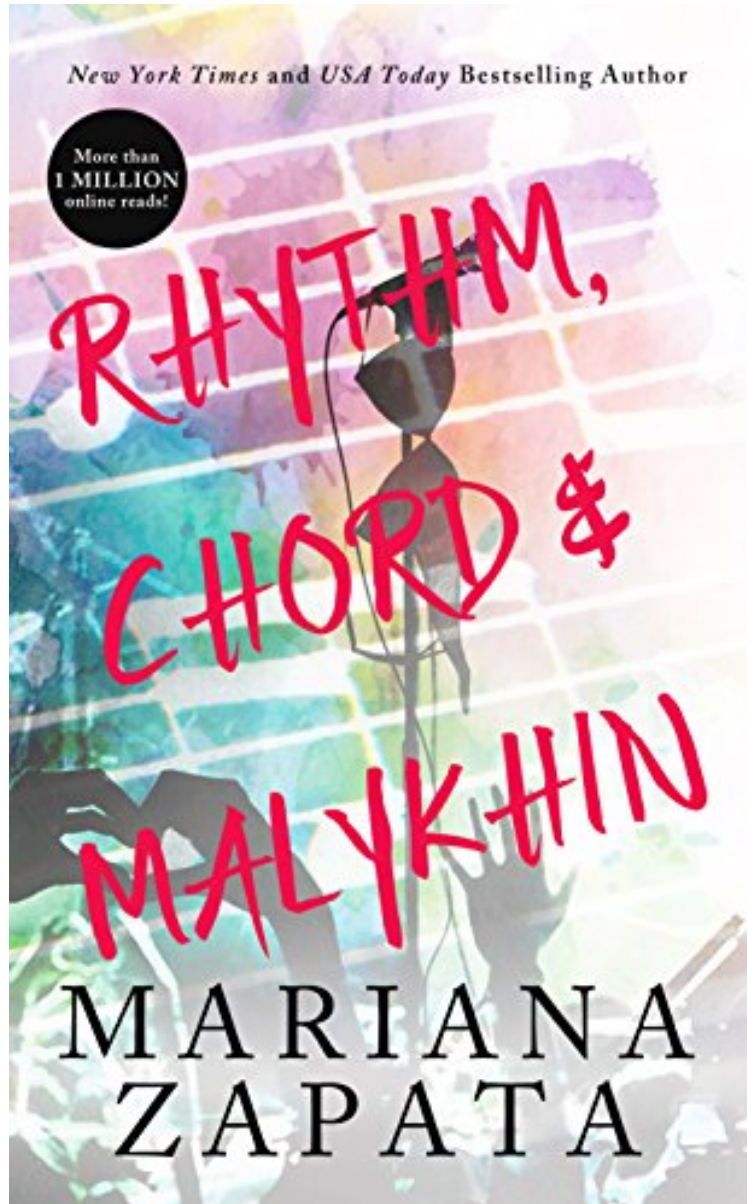

I've loved this before, when it was still a fanfiction starring the Twilight cast and I was willing to pay for it now even though I read it for free a couple years ago. But I was really bothered at how little changes have been made to the fanfiction. Only the names, some family relationships and some backstories were rewritten. I would have loved for the author to do more to the story. Don't get me wrong, I really meant it when I said I've loved this story in its original state. But to have next to no new elements to the story feels bad for old fans. Give them something, please. The other thing that really annoyed me was the editing of the book. This was published online before, so there is absolutely no reason why there should be any mistakes in grammar or spelling in the book. Same goes for editing mistakes. Worst thing? There was actually a remnant of the fanfiction left in, which made absolutely no sense for the 'new' characters. Why does the hero suddenly have green eyes by the end of the book when he had grey ones the 160 pages before that? Yes, because he used to be Edward Cullen. This book is only 172 pages! And it was previously published. There is no room for those mistakes, it is just lazy publishing. That said, I have those problems because I know the original. It deserved to be published as a real book, no doubt about it, even though the editing was sloppy and the story could have easily been fleshed out more. If you are not familiar with the fanfiction, go ahead and buy this book right now! It is still - with all those problems for old fans - a great and well written and very entertaining, heartwarming story. And if you are familiar with the author's other books you will really enjoy the glimpses of them in this one.
