Furthermore, if you're new to the series, you have no chance to get into it here. So in that case I recommend to start with Priceless or any of its prequel novellas.ReviewWhen reviewing the prior novella Stitched, I said it probably wouldn't be necessary to read it in order to keep up with things in Rylee's life and quest. Well, I stand by my word, but I have to add that I was glad here to know what happened between Wounded and Rising Darkness, because it really answered a lot of questions I otherwise would have had. And maybe these questions would have bothered me so I recommend to you to read the novella, if you haven't already.Somewhere along this series, the world has grown very dark and Liam's sacrifice in the last book made it clear that even if Rylee somehow managed to defeat the uber-demon Orion, there would be prices to pay and that there are no assurances that everyone will manage to make it out alive. This is something I admire and hate S. Mayer for: she has no qualms killing off characters you've grown fond of and to redeem others that seemed totally lost.So this is again what is happening here. When Rylee comes back from her reprieve with her daughter, the world is on the edge of the end of days already. The riders of the apocalypse have unleashed a plague that kills humans and supernaturals alike and that Rylee's blood can cure the sick just doesn't make life any easier for her, since desperate supernaturals tend to not care if their blood donor survives. And while people die in masses, Orion makes his play, dangles the cure in front of everyone, posing as the savior just as he told Rylee he would. And while he is at it, he makes sure, Rylee and friends are tagged as criminals so Rylee and her posse are persecuted by everyone and no place is safe.Again S. Mayer excels at transporting this breathless and dark atmosphere and one wonders how Rylee doesn't get lost in desperation facing what she has to. But then, I also believe Ms. Mayer why Rylee has reasons to live and not give up. All the characters feel three dimensional and very real in their struggles and when Pamela makes her choices that were hinted at in Wounded, it's understandable why she does what she does [that doesn't mean I wasn't aggravated by it]. And I liked it that there were dire consequences that had to be faced that people die and nothing can be done about it.Telling you about the plot is done in a few sentences. Rylee has to track the Devourer, one elemental who is said to know of a way to kill Orion. The search is made harder by the ill supernaturals who always seem to know where Rylee is and who want her blood as a cure. Then there is the problem of the demons latching on to her whenever she Tracks. And Pamela being on a perilous and pivotal path. If you're wondering, if that was it, I have to tell you: yes. Plot-wise this very much is it. This is why I gave the book only 3,5 stars. It's the preparation for the last stand, the final showdown, but it feels not like a rounded up story on its own. Well that and the appearance of the weirdest love/lust-triangle ever. I detest them at the best of times and here, I really don't know what to think about it. Nope. I know: I don't like it. It creeps me out and I have no idea where the author is headed.But then, I'm a huge fan of the series as a whole and Rylee in particular, so I will trust Ms. Mayer and faithfully read the final book in autumn.
