But I picked it up nevertheless because it came highly recommended by somebody whose works I enjoy, and the title starts making perfect sense as you get sucked into a story that is hilarious and romantic and hot and lovely and modern and historical, all rolled into one. What a fantastic read, what a wonderful cast of characters! Although I do expect authors of historical romances to do their homework, I do not expect 100% accuracy or pages of source material when I pick up a romance. I realise this one may occasionally feel very modern, and yet, it never annoys. I think the mixture of historical setting and a modern approach/brushover works very well here, and I found myself laughing out loud, sighing, drumming my fingers nervously in short, thoroughly enjoying myself. I liked the main characters at first sight, and I liked them even better as they slowly changed, and I loved how they complemented each other. Izzy might appear a damsel in distress when she makes her appearance, and Ransom might be yet another broken hero, but there's so much more to them and it's a joy watching them grow together. The nod to modern fandom? Wonderful! I have no idea if something like the Moranglians cosplayers at their very finest actually existed way back when, but who cares. It was a great idea that added so much colour and detail, and I much enjoyed reading about them. A good storyteller knows how to mix facts with fiction to keep his or her readers spellbound, and spellbound I was. I read until I couldn't keep my eyes open any longer, I read on the train to work and almost missed my stop. I love this book so much and I was disappointed when it ended. I'm going to re-read it soon, if only to mark my favourite passages and add them to my Kindle clippings.
